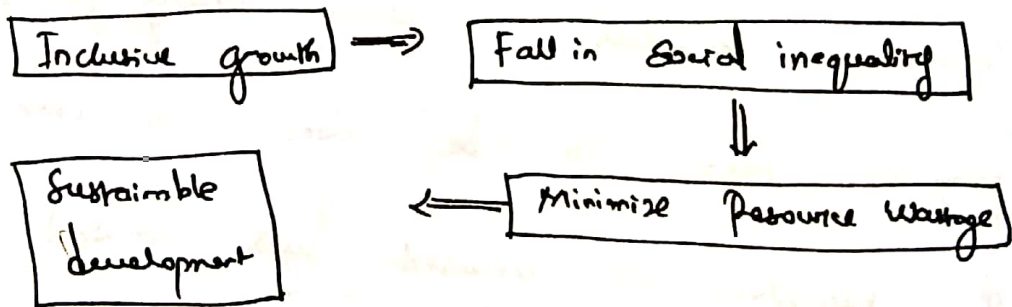
Inclusiveness / Inclusive growth : Inclusive
