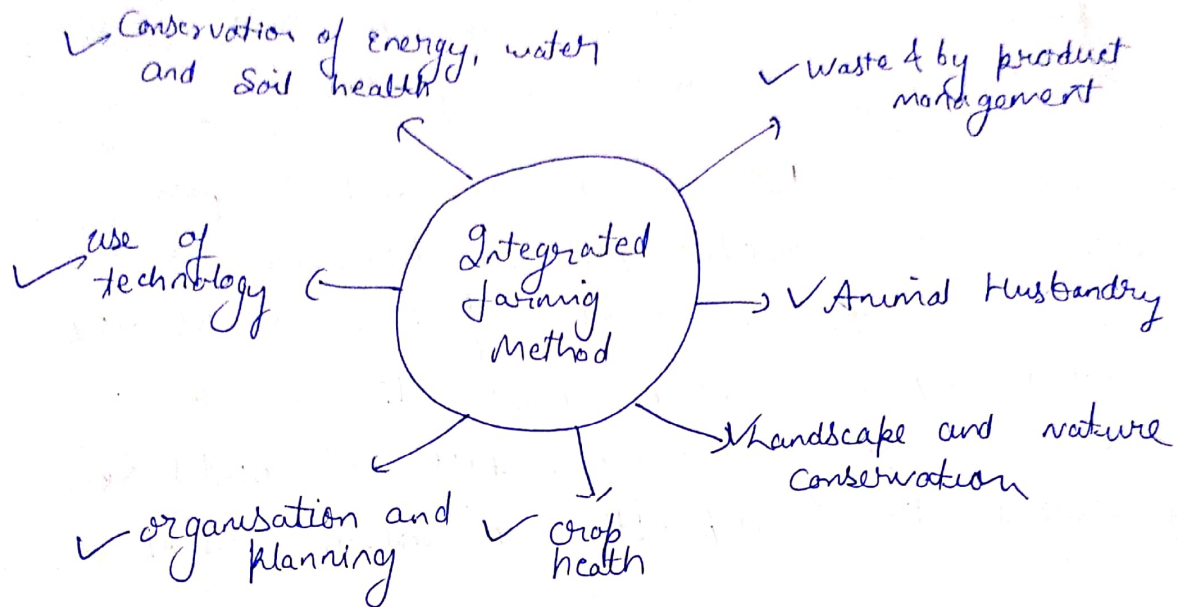


③ Integrated farming method is a sustainable agricultural practice which is an interplay of various activities.
